John 10:10 A Positive Salvation

I. Introduction

- 🌠 A. Christ's salv takes away/subtracts/leaves us with less Good cos He takes away bad things; damages/destroys us; sin, guilt, etc
 - A 1. Not only neg/takes away but also adds acceptance, pardon, joy, peace, and many other graces. It gives life "abundant life."
 - √2. "I don't need life, abundant or otherwise. I'm perfectly happy with my life." I could disprove claim, won't last, death
 - P3. I'll focus on "A Positive Salvation" Christian life is the abundant life and hope to persuade you that you need it, seek it
- B. Why did Jesus come to earth?
 - A 1. Answers: "To teach people...to help people....to make people better...to feed the hungry...to deliver the poor...to spoil fun..."
 - ₹ 2. His answer. "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly."
- ① 3. Lots of people in this world and they really exist to drain life from you." They are life-suckers, even life-killers religious/fleece)

II. He Gives Abundant Spiritual Life

- A. <u>Dead in trespasses/sins: our is dead, lifeless.</u> Not just weak/dead. Not just sick/dead. Not just drowning/drowned.
 - = 1. Not floating in the water waiting for somebody to throw a lifebelt; it's face down, water-filled lungs, cold lifeless heart.
 - 2. Doesn't need a lifebelt. It needs a lifeguard and mouth-to-mouth, or spirit-to-spirit resuscitation. Jesus is lifeguard/belt
 - √3. Wait, floating face-down for our life-guard? No, wour physical life, our bodily life, we can ask for/seek spiritual life.
- 8. Jesus did not come just to make sure we knew we were dead in sins. "I am come that they might have life." Starting/end point
 - 1. DNC to make us deader, to sink us deeper, to kick our corpses, but to get us out of death, raise us higher, put life in our corpses.

- 2. DNC as the reluctant, hesitant life-giver. My whole purpose, ultimate aim, my life's work is life.
- C. Spiritual life is simply that life...and liveliness in spiritual things.
 - 2 1. Spiritual activity: repenting from sin, believing, trusting, loving Christ, choosing the right way for right reasons and ends.
 - 2. A dimension of living that we previously knew nothing about. Know about physical life before you were born?
 - 2. Spiritual life can only be given by Christ. Without His kiss of spiritual life, we will never repent, believe, love God, worship

III.He Gives Abundant Intellectual Life

- A. Many think that when you become a Christian you park your brain at the door/lose your mind, intellectual suicide Educators, etc
- 1. Ligonier motto Christian faith is so intellectually satisfying and even thrilling Whole new intellectual life
- B. New subjects to learn about God, the human heart, salvation, atonement, 3 persons, ST, BT, PT, CH, More than greatest mind
- C. New mind: a new way of thinking, mental energy, ability to think, reason, ask questions and find answers. Enlightening
- D. New glasses to view and read other subjects. Mind soaked in God's Word, the Christian also wants to study God's World.
 - 1. God's world in a completely new light. She reads books and listens to lessons with a new filter, a new clarity, a new perception
 - 2. Subjects look so different We see what we never saw before, we see from new angles, we see with new insight,
- E. New challenges. Prior to conversion we made decisions based upon self-interest and short-term gain. But now we have to search the Scriptures, prayerfully seek God's help in applying it to our lives.
- F. New framework that holds it all together (worldview): Knew lots but didn't hold together > a grid, a structure, rels btw ev/God

IV. He Gives Abundant Emotional Life

- A. Christians: "Poor people, they don't know how to enjoy themselves." Shriveled humanity who have live lives of gloom and doom.
 - 1. Christ came to give abundant emotional life. He came to purify, deepen, heighten, add to our emotions (sad and unpleasant too)
- B. Joy of being a Christian: loved with an everlasting love; love divine, all loves excelling; forgiveness; adoption; hearing God B. Joy of being a Christian: loved will all everlasting love, love divine, and the conscience, in the midst of trouble, facing death and judgment, false acc, financial loss C. Peace. Cleansed conscience, in the midst of trouble, facing death and judgment, false acc, financial loss
- D. Confidence. Lack of confidence hampers life Assurance gives boldness in prayer, in preaching, in witnessing, to fight Satan.
- E. Hope. Live w/o? Future will be better than the past...sun will rise...life after death and that I have title to that life,

V. He Gives Abundant Social Life

- A. Divine friendship. Abraham/ev Christian friend of God. Mutual naming 3 infinite inexhaustible persons to know (new discovery)
- Deep friendship: deep spiritual friendships based on deepest truths and shared experiences Friend who asks q's about deeps
- V. C. Wide friendship: Across the ages, genders, races, nations, languages, cultures (counter-everything)

LD. Long friendships:

- ∠ 1. Lifelong but like all friendships in this world, they can be ended by death, by distance, or even by the devil
- 2. Christian friendships however will continue into eternity, be revived in eternity, repaired in eternity. Contrast that with hell
- ✓ 3. Life-giving friendship v life-taking friendship" Not just Pharisees but anyone that gets between you and life in Christ.

VI. He Gives Abundant Physical Life

- A. Generally Christians live healthier and longer lives (Exodus 20:12; Prov. 3:7,8) but main focus is on ress life
- B. Teenagers set the bar too low We will be Olympian.

He Gives Abundant Eternal Life

- (2) A. Not primarily about length of time but quality of time. Focus not on "eternal" or "never ends" but "life", abundant life
- C. Life begun here is not brought to a climax when we die, it will feel as if we've never really lived at all (bump/bounce illus)
- D. We see life depart, they experience life just beginning. "He's dead." "I've come to life." Immediate, immense, immeasurable life.

VIII. He Gives Abundant life

- A. See how abundant this life is? Can you see how positive this salvation is? This is not just surviving. This is thriving.
- B. Price: His life/death (11, 15, 17). Our abundant life was bought by his abundant death. Abandoned his life > have abundant life.
- C. Your response? "You will not come to me that you might have life" (John 5:40). Today, judgment, eternity?
- D. This is not an excuse you can lean on, it's heaping full resp upon you. Not a sharing of the blame, piling all blame on you (dispute)
- E. I am come that you might have life and that you might have it more abundantly. You will not come to me that you might have life.
- F. Come to Him for a positive salvation. Come to Him for life. Come to Him for abundant life. More than deserve/imagine/promise
